The production will be recorded professionally by Bullseye Productions in a digital format. We will be making recordings available for sale in various formats - USB, Digital Card etc. - more on this soon! Having to record in this way is recognition that DVD's are phasing out and various digital options are now necessary!

Andy Galbraith who will be recording the show is going to try and make sure he captures every child at some point. We will put out a note for orders early next week - price likely to be \$15.00 per copy. This is to be confirmed. Having the show recorded in this way is not cheap - especially with the new digital platforms that we will be offering for sale - hence the \$15.00 cost. Money from the sales will not even cover the cost of having it recorded.


