

## Ōhope Beach School – Alert Level 1 Procedures

Alert level 1 sees everyone being able to return without restrictions to work, school, sports and domestic travel, and you can get together with as many people as you want. These procedures have been developed with the safety of staff and students in mind. We will work to ensure that school is the safest possible place for your children to be.



PICK UP AND DROP OFF	CLASSROOMS	ATTENDANCE AND TRACKING
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The school gate will be opened at 8.00am.</li> <li>• Parents will be able to drop their children off at their classroom.</li> <li>• We have observed increased independence in many of the children and, with your support, we would like to see this maintained.</li> <li>• The gates will be opened at 2.25pm each day.</li> <li>• When picking up your child after school we ask that you please wait outside the classroom.</li> <li>• If you wish to talk with the teacher, please wait until the teacher has been able to see the children safely on their way.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Good hygiene and regular cleaning of commonly touched surfaces will continue.</li> <li>• Hand sanitizer and soap will be available in every classroom and the office.</li> <li>• Health protection posters will be displayed in all classrooms</li> <li>• Students are to bring their own named water bottles.</li> <li>• We discourage the sharing of food at school.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is expected that students will return to on-site learning at Level 1.</li> <li>• Any children and staff will stay home if they are sick.</li> <li>• If your child is going to be away from school, for any reason, please make contact via the school office or the school app.</li> <li>• If you have cold or flu symptoms call your doctor or Healthline and make sure you get tested.</li> <li>• Children will be sent home if they show any symptoms or if they are unwell.</li> <li>• Our contact tracing for students will utilise our class timetables and attendance register. These will provide information to the health authorities if they need to contact people that might be considered a close contact of a confirmed case.</li> <li>• Our contact register will be used to record any contractors or visitors who come on site.</li> <li>• All visitors (not parents) to the school must come in via the school office.</li> </ul>
CLEANING AND HYGIENE	PLAYGROUNDS	BUSES / GATHERINGS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sanitizer, disinfectant spray bottles, soap and tissues will be available in every classroom, in the office and in the staffroom.</li> <li>• Posters about handwashing, sanitising and coughing and sneezing will be provided for each space.</li> <li>• Soap, paper towels and hand driers will be available in bathrooms.</li> <li>• The cleaning contractor will continue with cleaning practices.</li> <li>• Disinfectant and cleaning cloths will be available in classrooms for teachers to sanitise spaces and equipment during the day as required.</li> <li>• Teacher aides will clean and sanitise any spaces, they are working in, regularly.</li> <li>• Wash your hands, wash your hands, wash your hands will be the message to students</li> <li>• Sneeze and cough into your elbow, and regularly disinfect shared surfaces.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School playgrounds, sports equipment use, and activities will continue.</li> <li>• Physical education classes and break time activities can include access to sports equipment, including playgrounds.</li> <li>• Students will be encouraged to wash their hands after using playgrounds and sports equipment as a hygiene measure.</li> <li>• Drinking fountains will be available but we do encourage students to continue with a named drink bottle at school.</li> <li>• Students can bring their own scooters and bikes to school.</li> <li>• We encourage a change of clothes in bags at this time of year just in case children get wet or muddy while playing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will return to our Friday morning assemblies in term three.</li> <li>• School bus transport will resume for the children who travel on the town bus.</li> <li>• After school care will continue, parents /caregivers will be able to collect children from the hall.</li> </ul>
