



## Ōhope Beach School Protection Framework at Orange Settings May 2022

I do hope you have all enjoyed the school holiday break. We are looking forward to welcoming the children back to school next Monday, 2nd May.

We have updated our procedures for the new term which reflect the move to the Orange settings on the covid protection framework (CPF).

If your child is sick they are required to stay home. If they have a cold, flu or Covid-19 symptoms please get tested. Under the orange setting the 7 day isolation period still applies for both Covid positive and household contact. Please notify the office if your child tests positive or is a household contact.

<b>Key Message</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ōhope Beach School will be open for on site learning for all students.</li> </ul>
<b>Drop off and pick up</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The school will be open for you to come in with your child/children in the morning and for pickup after school.</li> <li>• If you are entering the class we ask that you wear a mask while indoors.</li> <li>• When picking up your child after school we ask that you wait outside the class.</li> </ul>
<b>Health Measures</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We will continue to promote and teach safety measures:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hand washing, sanitiser, safe coughing, how to wear masks, social distancing.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• If your child is sick they are to stay at home and please notify the office.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Sick children and their siblings will be sent home if they become unwell while at school.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Face Masks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face masks are strongly encouraged to be worn when indoors - students and staff.</li> <li>• Visitors are asked to wear masks when indoors.</li> </ul>
<b>Classrooms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Windows and doors will be open as much as possible to provide ventilation.</li> <li>• Tissues, liquid soap and hand sanitizer will be available in all classes.</li> </ul>
<b>School Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Schoolwide activities will resume this term.</li> <li>• Assembly will be held each Friday morning from 8.40am. If you are attending we ask that you wear a mask while in the hall.</li> <li>• Choir will be available for students during each Tuesday lunch break.</li> <li>• Kapa haka will be available for students during each Thursday lunch break.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A range of clubs and activities will be offered each lunch break this term.</li> <li>• Sports and interschool sports can take place. We have crosscountry and gymnastics on the calendar for this term.</li> </ul>
<b>Visitors</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visitors are able to come on site and are asked to follow the sign in procedures. Sign in can be carried out in the office.</li> <li>• If you are dropping off or picking up your child you do not need to sign in at the office.</li> <li>• All visitors, including parents and caregivers are encouraged to wear a mask when indoors.</li> </ul>

The government have advised that there is to be an announcement on May 3rd. We will make any changes to our procedures should any arise following this announcement.
