PJ Project:

The Whakatāne Kāhui Ako comprises ten schools (Allandale, Apanui, Awakeri, James St, Ōhope Beach, St Joseph's Whakatāne, Te Kura ō Te Pāroa, Whakatāne Intermediate, Whakatāne High School and

Trident High School) along with 21 Early Children Centres from the Whakatāne region.

The PJ project focuses on providing new warm pyjamas to children in the EBOP region and nationally.


